Speak Up About Safety Violations, Without Fear

If you notice a hazard on the farm, bring the conditions to your supervisor's or employer's attention.

If your employer is not protecting you from workplace hazards as required, you have the <u>right</u> <u>to report them</u>.

The Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) is a federal enforcement agency that helps prevent and protect workers from being killed or seriously injured while at work.

There are 5 ways:

- <u>Online</u>: Submit your online complaint to OSHA at <u>https://www.osha.gov/ords/osha7/</u> <u>eComplaintForm.html</u>
- <u>Fax or email</u>: Fax or email the online complaint form to your local OSHA office. Include your contact information.
- <u>Mail</u>: Send a letter describing your complaint to your local OSHA office.
- <u>In person</u>: Visit your local OSHA office .

You <u>never</u> have to reveal your immigration status to OSHA .
